

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-04

A Resolution opting out of Governor Kelly's Executive Order No. 20-68 relating to mandatory mask wearing.

WHEREAS, on November 18, 2020, Governor Kelly issued Executive Order No. 20-68 that dictated a statewide mandate relating to wearing of masks; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority granted to it by K.S.A. 48-925 (as amended by L. 2020, Chapter 1, Section 33), the Board of County Commissioners has consulted with the Chase County Public Health Officer regarding the governor's mandate; and

WHEREAS, following such consultation, the Board of County Commissioners FINDS that the implementation of the governor's mandate is no longer necessary to protect the public health and safety of the county.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be it Resolved by the Board of Chase County Commissioners in special session assembled, that, effective immediately, Governor Laura Kelly's mandate set forth in Kansas Governor Executive Order No. 20-68 is no longer effective in Chase County, Kansas.
